Vulnerable to Valuable

Vulnerable to Valuable displays the progression of three ribbon skirts, depicting the generational impacts of passing down trauma, but also healing. The intention of the mural is to discuss and overcome gender-based violence. The creators wanted to focus on the Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women's Movement.



SKIRT 1 The AR inside this skirt shows the highway of tears representing the countless Indigenous women that experience violence, have gone missing or have been murdered.



SKIRT 2 This skirt holds AR that expresses the red hand movement, which represents the rising number of young women that are standing up and bringing awareness and change.



SKIRT 3 The AR associated with this skirt shows a baby buffalo representing Indigenous women reclaiming their culture with the hope that violence will no longer have to be the focus of our young women and girls.
